

Analysis of sulfadimidine

The permissible level of sulfadimidine, a veterinary antibacterial agent, residual in foodstuffs and the analytical methods used to determine it, are controlled according to food hygiene laws 1,2.




Fig. 1 Structure of sulfadimidine




Fig.2 Chromatogram of 1 ppm sulfadimidine standard sample




Fig. 3 UV spectrum of sulfadimidine

The structure of sulfadimidine is shown in Fig. 1. Following the official method, the chromatogram from the analysis of a standard sample of sulfadimidine is shown in Fig. 2 and the absorption spectrum by photodiode array, in Fig. 3.

Conditions:

Column: CrestPak C18S
Eluent: CH₃CN/25mM NaH₂PO₄(15/85)
Wavelength: 268nm(UV-970)
Flow rate: 0.8mL/min
Column temperature: 40 degree celsius
Sample: STD (1ppm)
Injection volume: 20uL
